



License of HPAC/ACVL Trademark HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark

Definitions

“HPAC/ACVL” means the Hang Gliding and Paragliding Association of Canada Inc.

“Licensee” means any HPAC/ACVL certified instructor who meets the requirements specified in HPAC/ACVL SOP-420.

“HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark” means either of the following combined word marks, incorporating the HPAC/ACVL registered trademark.;



1. Grant of License

HPAC/ACVL hereby grants to each Licensee, a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use exact electronic or print reproductions of the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark, subject to the terms herein, on Licensee’s website, printed materials and business card providing that the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark is clearly associated only with Licensee.

Any use of the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark by Licensee signifies Licensee’s acceptance of all terms herein.

Licensee shall not alter the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark including but not limited to any changes to add additional text, adjust ratio of elements within the logo, delete elements, or incorporate other marks. Uniform resizing is permitted, provided that clarity and readability is not affected adversely.

Where the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark is used on a web page, it shall link to www.hpac.ca or www.acvl.ca.

NEITHER HPAC/ACVL NOR ANY THIRD PARTY SHALL BE LIABLE FOR ANY DIRECT, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, IN CONTRACT OR IN TORT, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO ANY USE OR DISTRIBUTION OF THE HPAC/ACVL CERTIFIED FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR MARK.

Without limiting the generality of the forgoing, it is the intent of this license that any casual observer of any use of the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark could only reasonably associate the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark with Licensee, and not mistakenly conclude that the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark is an endorsement of a school, business or club, or a person other than Licensee.

2. Termination and Amendment

This license may be terminated or amended at any time by the Board of HPAC/ACVL.

This license shall terminate immediately upon termination, cancellation or expiration of Licensee’s HPAC/ACVL instructor certification.

The license granted herein shall terminate 90 days after written notification by the HPAC/ACVL, detailing alleged violations of the terms and conditions herein, unless Licensee takes action to a) provide evidence satisfactory to the HPAC/ACVL that the alleged violations did not occur, or b) document and effect remedial steps satisfactory to the HPAC/ACVL to prevent further violations. The HPAC/ACVL Board of Directors shall have sole and final authority in this regard.

Licensee agrees to cease all use of the HPAC/ACVL Certified Flight Instructor Mark and destroy or deface all business cards and/or printed materials bearing the mark within 30 days of termination of the license granted herein.
